INTRODUCTION

Beech House veterinary Clinic [BHVC] respects your personal information and undertakes to comply with all applicable Data Protection legislation currently in force.

- 1. Contract: the processing is necessary for a contract we have with you.

- 3. Vital interests: the processing is necessary to protect someone's life.
- 4. Public task: the processing is necessary to perform a task in the public interest or for official functions, and the task or function has a clear basis in law.
- 5. Legitimate interests: the processing is necessary for our or your legitimate interests or the legitimate interests of a third party unless there is good reason to protect the individual's personal data which overrides those legitimate interests.

Except as provided under these terms, BHVC will not disclose your personal information without your permission unless such disclosure is required by law or other court order.

You are entitled to request a copy of the information which BHVC holds about you. If you become aware that the personal information BHVC holds about you is inaccurate, you may request that we amend it. Any request in this respect or any other correspondence relating to this notice should be directed to Alan Beatty.

Where processing is based upon consent, you have the right to withdraw consent at any time which will not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal.
