The rules have been updated by the RCVS regarding the dispensing of certain medications. For us to be able to dispense antibiotics, anti-fungal medications and controlled medications, the patient must be seen.

For Equipalazone, Equioxx, Danilon and Pergoquin/Prascend, these medications can be dispensed without a visit following a conversation with the vet at their discretion
